

HELLO HYDERABAD

5 Days / 4 Nights

DAY 01 KUALA LUMPUR - HYDERABAD

Board your flight to Hyderabad. You will be met on arrival at the Rajiv Gandhi International Airport, Hyderabad. Proceed to hotel for check-in. Overnight.

DAY 02 HYDERABAD (B)



After breakfast, you will visit the world famous Ramoji Film City. Later, drive past Hyderabad City & Hussain Sagar Lake. Overnight.

Ramoji Film City is a sprawling complex, a self-contained world and the first of its kind in Asia. This multi-billion-dollar city attracts film units from around the world including Hollywood. It can accommodate the largest of film crews. There are forty studio floors equipped with all facilities to make up to one hundred films at a time. Visit the cinema Ghar which showcases the art and craft of filmmaking and painting. The tour of this exciting complex is conducted by the Film City people themselves in open buses and lasts for 1 to 2 hours.





DAY 03 HYDERABAD (B)



After breakfast, proceed on a full day tour to Golconda Fort, Qutab Shahi Tombs, Charminar, Salarjung Museum, Chowmahalla Palace, Laad Bazaar & Birla Temple. Overnight.





Golconda Fort & Qutab Shahi Tombs - built on a picturesque granite hill. From here the Qutab Shahi ruled in the 16th and 17th centuries, before shifting their capital to Hyderabad in 1590 AD. The fort has three ramparts and a perimeter of about seven miles. The fort contains citadels, numerous mosques, tombs, pavilions and baradaris.

Nearby are the tombs of seven Qutab Shahi kings, built in an old rose garden called the Ibrahim Bagh. In its heyday, the six-mile-long road from Hyderabad to Golconda was a fabulous bazaar selling jewelry, diamonds, pearls and other gems and trinkets. The tombs are domed structures on square bases surrounded by pointed arches. The center of the tomb is the sarcophagus built over the actual burial vault in the crypt below.

Char Minar - The famous landmark of Hyderabad, the Charminar built in 1591 AD is in the heart of the city. It is 180 feet high, built in typical Qutab-Shahi style, crowned in the four corners with graceful minarets.

Salar Jung Museum - the world's largest one man collection of priceless antiques, Mughal miniatures, Chinese porcelain, clocks and many other wondrous artifacts

Also visit **Chowmahalla Palace**, is the palace of the Nizams of Hyderabad State in Hyderabad It was the seat of the Asaf Jahi dynasty and was the official residence of the Nizams of Hyderabad while they ruled their state. The palace was built by Nizam Salabat and remains the property of the Nizam.

Birla Temple, is a Hindu temple, built on a 280 feet (85 m) high hillock called Naubath Pahad on a 13 acres plot in Hyderabad.

DAY 04 HYDERABAD (B)





After breakfast, visit Yadagirigutta temple [90 Kms/ 2 hrs drive]. Sri Lakshmi Narasimha Swamy Temple or simply known as Yadadri or Yadagirigutta temple, is a Hindu temple situated on a hillock in the small town of Yadagirigutta in the Yadadri Bhuvanagiri district of the Indian state of Telangana. The temple is an abode of Narasimha, an incarnation of Lord Vishnu. Later visit Shilparamam, a craft village which presents various traditional arts and crafts by artisans from all over the country. Thereafter return to your hotel. Overnight.





DAY 05 HYDERABAD - KUALA LUMPUR
